### **SCHOOL HEALTH UPDATE-** Kathy Bokeno, Lead School Nurse

- Kathy Bokeno, Lead School Nurse reports the nurses have been busy doing vision and hearing screenings for all 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> grades in all schools. In addition they have been performing vision only screenings for the 2<sup>nd</sup> graders. There have been 14 vision referrals from one elementary school. The 2<sup>nd</sup> grade vision screenings is a new recommendation we have just started this year.
- Kathy Bokeno reported the Friendly Dental Van is now serving 8 schools including Elementary, Middle and High School. We are still in the process of gathering information to report numbers as the Van is still making its rounds through the county.
- Kathy Bokeno recently accompanied Beth Edwards to a Rotary Meeting and shared with those present all the services and duties our (7) school nurses perform in all (12) of our schools.

### **DENTAL UPDATE-** Becky Boulton, State Dental Hygienist

- Becky Boulton, State Dental Hygienist reported the sealant program at William R Davie will begin next week, there are 37 students signed up so far. They are targeting 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> graders for this session.
- A dentist assesses each student and gives recommendation as to the students' needs. Normally 4-6 sealants are used per student.
- The sealant program will be held at Cooleemee Elementary around the middle of February, their target will be 2<sup>nd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> graders. This program also offers educational information for the students.
- Becky is looking into possibly working with the Summer Reading Program which will target 3<sup>rd</sup> graders as well. She will update at a later date.

### **NEW BUSINESS**

- Mike Garner reported Youth Basketball sign-ups are still going down at the Recreation Center. He asks to encourage girls to sign up as the numbers are very low. The Brock Gym is still under renovation but should be ready when games start in December.
- The Suicide Prevention Task Force presented a program to the SHAC group. Brandi Patti, Dee Ann Reavis and Jeff Eads head up this task group and shared statistics of percentages, target groups and other information about suicide in Davie County over the last 6-7 years. The most recent year is showing a high percentage of attempted and /or suicide in the 11-20 year group.
- Discussion was brought up about having a Suicide Prevention Program to present at the next Professional Development Day for teachers /staff since they are sometimes the first person a student may talk to. Kathy Bokeno also suggested we consider adding Suicide Prevention to the SHAC Action Plan for 2015-16.
- Kathy Bokeno reported heights and weights are being gathered and will be on the BMI report that comes out in the spring. She says we continue to need extra programs to keep kids moving and active. This will certainly impact the Child Obesity Report.
