

STUDENT CLUBS

Requirements

All applications must be received to the office by September 5 via hand delivery or e-mail to Mrs. Gildein at gildeinmk@davie.k12.nc.us. This deadline is non-negotiable-no late applications will be accepted. A student's grades and conduct may be a factor for club involvement. Students need to be good ambassadors for Shady Grove Elementary School. Students need to be able to fulfill the duties of the club or they may be asked to be relieved of your duty. Most club duties occur immediately before or after school.

Description of Clubs

News Show – The students in this club will be responsible for producing a morning news show. Students will write and report the news over WSGE television. Students on the news team will need to arrive at school by 7:30 AM and commit to practicing at least one day per week. Creativity, good communication skills and self motivation are essential for the news team.

Newspaper – The students in this club will write, edit, publish and sell their own school newspaper four times per year. Students on the newspaper staff will meet before or after school two to four times per month.

Safety Patrol – The students on the safety patrol team are assigned an area of the school to monitor. Their duties include monitoring the safety and well being of the students who are in their assigned in their area before and after school. Students would need to be at assigned posts at 7:50 AM and 2:40 PM.

Mail Delivery – These students would maintain a mail delivery service within Shady Grove School. This club would run much like a post office with the team receiving, stamping and delivering mail to student's classrooms. Students would deliver mail two times per week and need to be at school by 7:50 AM.

Morning Buddies – These students would be assigned to a particular Kindergarten or 1st grade classroom teacher to assist students with unpacking, morning work, breakfast, reading or writing work. These students would need to be with their buddy by 7:55 AM.

Technology/Green Team-These students will ensure that all computers/projectors and TV's are turned off each day. We welcome your ideas regarding conservation projects.

Robotics-Robotics-These students learn to build and program robots as well as basic applications.
